Ketamine Facts

Ketamine is a dissociative anesthetic that alters perception, sight, and sound. It is used in medicine and veterinary care and also has powerful therapeutic properties for mental health treatment. It is abused, often in combination with heroin and marijuana, for the dissociate sensations and hallucinogenic effects it produces. It has also been used to facilitate sexual assault. Negative effects include central nervous system issues, liver and kidney problems and even death.

Ketamine is metabolized in the liver and detectable 2-4 hours after use.

Substance Use Monitoring: Screening tests are used in addiction recovery and family law cases to monitor abstinence.

Emergency and Safety: In emergency settings, ketamine is frequently tested for in cases of suspected drug-facilitated sexual assault due its propensity to cause rapid sedation and memory loss.

Clinical Therapy Clearance: Healthcare providers often require patients to pass drug screenings before beginning medical ketamine/esketamine therapy to ensure patient safety and compliance.
